Ballet Flats by Jenn Wisbeck

Baby Knitting Pattern

Adorable baby ballet flats knit flat using elastic yarn. Shaping comes from simple decreases. Just 17 rows and an easy to knit strap make these a quick to knit gift that can be knit up in an evening.

Level

Intermediate-
Increase and decrease.

Size

Newborn and up.
Finished length is 2.5
inches, if you use a
stretchy yarn the
slippers will stretch to 3
inches long.

Yarn

70 yards Patons Stretch
Sock Color 49

Materials

-US size 4 (3.5 mm)
knitting needles
-Tapestry needle to
weave in ends

Gauge

6 st/inch in garter stitch,
unstretched

Notes

Maizy or Panda Cotton would be good yarns subs. You could use a non stretchy yarn, but the stretch helps keep the booties on and gives a greater range of sizes.

Abbreviations

KFB- Increase 1 by knitting in front and back of stitch

SK2P- slip 1 stitch, knit two together, pass slipped stitch over

K2tog- Knit two stitches together
