



## Pickle Mitts by Jenn Wisbeck

### Mini Wrist Warmers with Thumb Opening

Quick to knit and great for gifts, mitts/wrist warmers are a versatile accessory for both men and women. The simple thumb opening spares you the increasing and shaping of a thumb gusset, and ribbing holds the mitts in place.

### Level

Intermediate- cast on, knit, purl, bind off, and use double pointed needles.

### Size

Small/Child (Medium, Large)  
6 (7.5, 8) inches around

### Yarn

150 yards heavy worsted or aran weight handspun- sample is yarn from Midnightsky Fibers

### Materials

- Size 5 double pointed needles, or size to get gauge
- A tapestry needle to weave in ends

### Gauge

4.5 stitches/inch. Do a gauge swatch to make sure you have the correct gauge.

### Notes

A good sub for handspun yarn would be Cascade Eco Wool, Merino Worsted Malabrigo, Silk Garden or Noro Kureyon, or Brown Sheep's Lamb's Pride Worsted.

### Abbreviations

St st- stockinette stitch (knit every round in the round, knit one row purl one row when working back and forth)

\* to \*\*- repeat sections with \* to \*\*
