



Elevation Hat by Jenn Wisbeck

Ribbed and Garter Stitch Beanie

The chained yarn adds a delightful bit of ever-so-slightly nubby texture while making for a very lightweight and warm hat. The bulky yarn knits up in just a few hours, making this great for gift knitting!

Level

Beginner- in the round, knit, purl, decrease

Gauge

19 stitches and 24 rows to 4"/10 cm in stockinette stitch, blocked

Size

Small (Medium, Large)

To Fit: 17.5 (19, 21)"/ 44.5 (48.5, 53.5) cm

Finished Size: 13.25 (15, 16.75)"/ 34 (38, 42.5) cm
around, 9"/23 cm high

Show in size Medium.

Yarn

85 (98, 110) yards/ 78 (90, 101) meters bulky
weight yarn.

Sample knit in: MountainTop Chalet by Classic Elite
Yarns (10% baby alpaca, 30% bamboo viscose; 98
yards/90 meters per 1.75 ounces/50 gram skein)
color 7477.

Cascade Yarns Cloud and Eco Cloud have a
similar chained texture and lightweight feel. Eco
Cloud and MountainTop Chalet are both undyed
yarns in natural colors.

Materials

- US #8/5 mm 16" circular and double pointed
(dpns) needles, or size to get gauge
- Tapestry needle to weave in ends
- 1 Stitch marker to mark start of round

Abbreviations

* to ** - Repeat from * to **

CO - Cast on

K - Knit

K2tog - Knit 2 stitches together

P - Purl

R - Row/round

St(s) - Stitch(es)
